

A BEAUTIFUL WALK OR BIKE ROUTE IN BRANFORD

This route goes between the Branford Green, with many restaurants, breweries, coffee shops and ice cream within half a mile and the village of Stony Creek, with restaurants, boat tours, and the Stony Creek Museum. Much of the route is off road on Shoreline Greenway Trail. Distance: about four miles.

From the Branford Green:

South on Montowese,
Under the railroad bridge onto South Montowese
Left onto Tabor Drive
Left into the Tabor Shoreline Greenway Trail
Across Pine Orchard Road to Birch Road (SGT)

*Across Birch Road through Young's Pond Park (SGT) if you are walking
IF YOU ARE BIKING *Young's Pond Park is unimproved trail. Bicycles may go left on Birch Road, right onto Sunset Hill Road, right onto Griffin Pond Road, right onto Totoket Rd.

Exit Young's Pond Park left onto Blackstone Avenue
Right on Totoket Road
Left on Tilcon Road
Left onto the Tilcon Drive SGT trail section
Left onto the Stony Creek Trolley Trail (SGT)
Ends at Thimble Island Road and the Willoughby Wallace Library.

From Stony Creek:

Opposite the Willoughby Wallace Library
Turn onto West Point Field Road straight to the walking path which is the Stony Creek Trolley Trail (SGT)
Right onto Tilcon SGT)
Right onto Totoket Road

**Left into Young's Pond Park (SGT) if you are walking
IF YOU ARE BIKING; **Young's Pond Park is unimproved trail. Bicycles would stay on Totoket, left onto Griffin Pond Road, left onto Sunset Hill Road, left onto Birch Road, right onto SGT trail

Go Across Birch Road to Pine Orchard Road (SGT) Across Pine Orchard Road to Tabor Trail (SGT) Right onto Tabor Drive
Right onto South Montowese
Under the railroad bridge to Montowese
Arrive at the Branford Green
